Guidance for Campgrounds to Slow the Spread of COVID-19

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) wants to provide additional information related to the “Safer at Home” emergency order issued on March 24, 2020.

While the directive does not specifically address campgrounds, please follow these recommendations if your facility is currently in operation:

- **Maintain social distancing** of 6 feet at all times.
- **Prohibit the use of buildings or public spaces** that would encourage social gatherings of any number of people.
- **Limit all campsites to members of a single household or living unit.** All other private gatherings of any number of people are prohibited.
- **Increase the cleaning frequency** of shared toilet facilities, laundry facilities and shower buildings.

This order remains in effect until 8 a.m. on Friday, April 24, or until a superseding order is issued.
